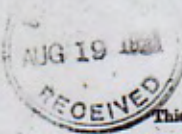

Holt (now 2nd Lieut. Holt) made a statement that the above-mentioned soldier was a Prisoner of War and severely wounded.

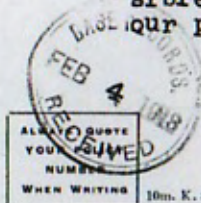
